The Collection

The library's resources are available to the college community and also to residents of Atlantic and Cape May counties. The book collection includes more than 70,000 books and about 250,000 digital books. The library subscribes to magazines that focus on areas of study as well as a variety of topics of interest to the college community.

The library offers <u>digital resources</u> to meet the needs of all of the academic departments. A popular resource is <u>Films on</u> <u>Demand</u>, a video streaming service with documentaries, educational videos and news footage. Materials cover many academic subjects including Education, Psychology, Heath, Music, Drama and Theater, Philosophy, World Languages and Cultures, Religion and STEM subjects.

Thousands of full text newspapers, magazines, and scholarly journals are available through the online resources including *The Press of Atlantic City* and *The Philadelphia Inquirer*. In addition, there are digital subscriptions to <u>The New York Times</u> and <u>The Wall Street Journal</u>. Print copies of *The Press of Atlantic City*, *The Chronicle of Higher Education*, and many other titles are available in libraries. *The Chronicle of Philanthropy* is kept at the Mullock Family Library. In addition, we have <u>resource guides</u> that provide a wide range of information for faculty and students.
