PHIL115 : Philosophy in Literature

Philosophical concepts and methods will be extracted from the reading of selected fiction. Plot, characters and style of writing will be analyzed to find examples of how a philosophical view is dramatized in the fiction. Following the framework of PHIL102-Introduction to Philosophy, the basic branches of philosophy and some of the standard issues in these branches will be analyzed and constructively criticized.
